Covers checkups, prescriptions, broken bones, booster shots, eye glasses, hearing aids, dental care, hospitalization, behavioral health and more.

WHO WILL ACCEPT KCHIP?

All of Our Lady of Bellefonte Hospital Outreach Center physicians accept KCHIP as well as other physicians on the hospital staff. Call the *CareLine* at (606) 833-CARE (2273) for a physician referral or to obtain a list of these physicians.

The Medical Plaza Pharmacy at Our Lady of Bellefonte Hospital also accepts KCHIP.
